WHO WE ARE

Obria Medical Clinics is a nonprofit, life-affirming women's healthcare clinic staffed by professional and peer personnel which exists for the benefit of women and their children, both born and unborn, as well as for the fathers who wish to be involved.

OUR MISSION

To empower our community to make healthy decisions regarding their reproductive health, their family, and their sexual integrity by providing medical services, foundational education, and material services to women, youth, and families.



The Impact of Choice

In 2018 alone:

- 2,195 patient visits
- 587 ultrasounds performed
- 128 participants in our educational program, Thrive
- 6,032 material items distributed to expectant and new mothers
- 2,687 students instructed at schools through our sexual risk avoidance program, Empowered
- 14 participants in our post abortion care program

WHAT WE PROVIDE

MEDICAL PROGRAM

We provide compassionate care and evidence-based education to women regarding their reproductive health and family well-being.

Services include:

- Pregnancy testing
- Pregnancy decision consultation
- Limited ultrasound
- STD testing and treatment
- Abortion pill rescue
- Well-woman care
- Community referrals

THRIVE

Promotes and supports the client's emotional, spiritual, and personal growth through online pre-natal classes, individual DVD instruction, and a monthly evening group class. Clients who lack support are assigned a Personal Development Advocate who walks alongside them. While the clients learn, they have the opportunity to shop in our Baby Boutique for items such as diapers, wipes, clothing, and baby equipment.

EMPOWERED

Healthy Relationship Educators teach in middle schools, high schools and colleges, using healthy relationships curriculums that help to equip youth and young adults in making wholesome decisions toward optimal health. The educational focus is designed to help young people navigate the minefields of relationships, peer pressure, personal challenges, and the discovery of purpose.

POST ABORTION CARE

Obria offers hope and healing to individuals suffering from the emotional scars of abortion. In a confidential and safe environment, women can heal from the pain and trauma of their past through small group support. To learn more, visit <http://palmministry.com/>.
